The papers on Middle East and North Africa which are considered for proceedings, Topics in MENA volumes are those which are academically worthy, which were selected by the Editorial Advisory Board and which were presented in the sessions of the MEEA annual conferences. The articles selected and accepted do not reflect the opinions of the MEEA Board or its publisher/editor. Please note that since the electronic proceedings are initial versions of your paper, full versions can be published elsewhere and you retain your copyrights. If you have already published your paper, please send us the link to the journal, we will gladly put in a link for you in our index page.

The Editor and the Editorial Board reserve the right to reject papers that do not meet academic and publication criteria.

We will be editing and reformatting your paper before publication to be submitted pending your approval.

Statement of Ethics:

Authors, please make sure

- a) That all researched work submitted is original, prepared in a scholarly standard and is referenced,
- b) That all co-authors and researchers in the project are represented, and if there are any changes in mid-publication, all co-authors should acknowledge the changes,
- c) That appropriate acknowledgements are clearly stated including sources of funding if any,
- d) That all data sources are noted,
- e) That you correspond and comply with the editor and research associates of the volume with respect to inquiries about references, sources of data and if needed, proof of authorship,
- f) That you co-operate with any issues raised by co-authors or readers of your work, submitted in written form to the editor, which will then be presented to the Editorial Advisory Board of the particular volume of MEEA. If misconduct has been committed, the paper will be withdrawn, an apology will be called for and the author/s may be excluded from having any future paper considered for presentation in a conference proceedings.
- g) That you accept that the Editorial Advisory Board and the Editor has the final decision to publish.
